Resolutiion #2008-01 Lynden Township - Stearns County, Minnesota

A RESOLUTION TO CONDUCT A SPEED STUDY ALONG EAGLEWOOD ROAD

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a)(1) establishes a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on town roads in rural residential districts:

WHEREAS, a "rural residential district" is defined in Minn. Stat. ' 169.14, subd. 2(c) as "the territory contiguous to and including any town road within a subdivision or plat of land that is built up with dwelling houses at intervals of less than 300 feet for a distance of one-quarter mile or more";

WHEREAS, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following road or road segment does not meet the definition within a rural residential district as defined above:

Eaglewood Road from Stearns County Road 44, west and south to its termination

WHEREAS, the residents along such road segment seek speed control and enforcement;

WHEREAS, the local road authority, Lynden Township Board, believes a speed limit on Eaglewood Road should be less than 30 mph in order to be reasonable and safe under existing conditions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the town board of Lynden Township, Stearns County, Minnesota, to request the MN Department of Transportation to conduct an engineering and traffic investigation (speed study) along Eaglewood Road to determine if a different speed limit is appropriate in accordance with Minn. Stat. §169.14, subd. 5.
