

RESOLUTION 2019-04  
Lynden Township, Stearns County Minnesota  
A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A 35MPH SPEED ZONE  
IN A RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a) establishes a 35 m.p.h. speed limit on town roads in rural residential districts;

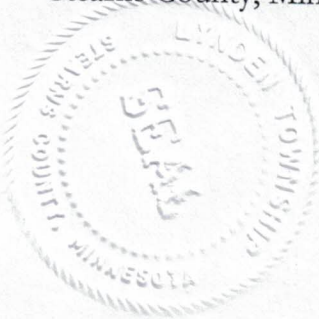
WHEREAS, a “rural residential district” is defined in Minn. Stat. § 169.011, subd. 69a, as “the territory contiguous to and including any ... town road that is built up with visible dwelling houses situated at intervals averaging less than 300 feet or less for a quarter mile or more.”;


WHEREAS, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following road segment is within a rural residential district as defined above: 200th Street, between 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Empire Road;


WHEREAS, as a town road within a rural residential district the legislature has established the speed limit to be 35 m.p.h. without the need for a speed study by the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of Lynden Township, Stearns County, Minnesota that a 35 M.P.H. zone is established on the above described road; that Lynden Township Resolution 2014-03 is rescinded; and, regulatory speed limit signs be erected on the above described road in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices.
