

2022 Lynden Township Fall Road Tour

Those present were Supervisors Dave Johnson, Dennis Niemi and Tom Plaggerman. The road tour began at Lynden Town Hall at 1:00 pm on September 20, 2022.

A list of issued raised during the tour are as followed:

Roads:

1. 8th Ave, north of 222nd St. W needs blading and west side of the road is washing out on the hill
2. 161st St. E, near the intersection with County Road 44 large sections of the chip coat has broken away on both sides of the road
3. Clear beaver dam out of south culvert on Lake Maria Rd

Signage:

1. 221st St E, Install a reflective diamond sign at the end of the cul-de-sac

Brush Clearing:

1. At the intersection of 6th Ave and 200th St, trim around the double arrow signs
2. Elderberry Rd, north of Elmwood Rd clear brush back on the south side of the road.
3. Woodbine Rd, south bound from Englewood Rd, clear branches from blocking the view of the street sign
4. Woodbine Rd. north bound from Craigway Rd, clear back branches and shrubs blocking the view of the DEAD END sign
5. 208th St E, from 9th Ave to County Rd 44 clear the Chinese Elm growing on the north side of the road, specifically around the STOP AHEAD sign approaching Co. Rd. 44
6. At the intersection of 222nd St E and Fairmont Rd, clear back the brush from around the Double Arrow signs
7. Franklin Road (minimum maintenance portion), clean back the branches hanging out in the roadway
8. Franklin Rd, east of 19th Ave E, long limb reaching out over the road to be trimmed back
9. Cresnet Rd, east from 4th Ave E, clean up brush and branches encroaching on the road way from the intersection to the bend to the north.
10. 200th St E, west bound nearing the intersection wit County Rd 44, clear vines growing up the post blocking the road sign, 35 MPH, HILL BLOCKD VIEW

Garbage:

1. Franklin Road (minimum maintenance portion), garbage in the ditch on the west side of the road near the north end of the road
2. Franklin Road (minimum maintenance portion), tire in the ditch west side of the road near the intersection of Franklin Rd and 222nd St E

Other Items:

1. PID 19.11054.0021, 295 Elderberry Rd, garden planted up to the edge of the road
2. Verify permits pulled for home at 15700 13th Ave
3. Check to see if striping was included in the bid for Birchwood Rd

The road tour concluded back at the Lynden Township Hall at 4:35 pm.
