

2023 Lynden Township Fall Road Tour

Those present were Supervisors Tom Plaggerman, Dennis Niemi, Scott O’Konek, Gary Schmidt and Township residents Dave Johnson. The road tour began at the Lynden Town Hall at 1pm on September 25th, 2023. List of issued raised during the tour are as followed:

Unresolved Issues:

1. LacQuay, 265 Elderberry Rd still has dirt and 2x4s framing up where he wanted to pour a third driveway

Signage:

1. Replaced the STOP sign at the intersection of 215th St. and 13th Ave
2. 200th ST Plum Creek sign missing
3. 200th st near 6th st intersection- corner right sign tipping over
4. Englewood dead end sign
5. 208th ST- signs bent over near CO RD 143 stop ahead sign and right corner sign
6. 9th ST/203rd ST missing street signs at corner
7. Eagle Wood RD watch for Children sign needs replaced near CR 44 intersection
8. Missing ↔ sign at Eagle Wood RD/5 TH Ave Intersection
9. Replace the Black Diamond sign at the end of Englewood Rd
10. Replace the Black Diamond sign at the end of Englewood Rd
11. Replace the WATCH FOR CHILDREN sign turning onto 189th St from County Rd 44
12. Replace the WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS sign located as you turn onto Fairfax Rd from Frankfurt Rd
13. **Missing Sign ** a Road Delineation (Obstruction Keep Left) sign where Franklin Rd crosses over Plum Creek
14. ** Missing Sign ** a WELCOME TO LYNDEN TWP at the very north end of Franklin Rd (minimum maintenance portion)
15. Eagle Wood Rd – Boat Landing Parking Place # signs and parking 1 parking place sign
16. Dunmore Circle- replace inside corner signs- all have been painted
17. Danforth Circle- flip intersection left sign, so it reads intersection right- just south of Davenport/Danforth intersection- shares same posts as a watch for children sign
18. Donaghue DR- No Dead End/Reflector sign?
19. Stop sign on 5th and 155th needs to be reset- leaning
20. 149th- NO Dead End or Reflector sign?

Brush Clearing:

1. Frankfurt Infront of corner right sign
2. 8th St in front of corner right sign
3. 200th ST near plum creek crossing brush growing into road
4. 6th AVE trim brush Infront of stop sign
5. Lake Maria Rd- dead tree just past plum creek crossing over hanging road
6. Woods edge RD- Clear brush Infront of corner right sign
7. 208th ST- Infront of stop ahead sign
8. Eagle Wood RD- clear brush in front of dead-end reflectors sign
9. Eagle Wood RD right corner sign north of boat landing- clear brush

10. Woolston CT- Brush in front of corner sign
11. 200th st Vegetation blocking signs and grown into guard rails
12. 200th st/ Edison CIR- brush blocking stop sign
13. 193rd ST- Brush blocking stop sign
14. Dunmore Circle- brush Blocking 30 MPH sign
15. Birchwood Rd- Trim overhanging branches on corner
16. Basswood Rd- clear brush in front of stop sign
17. 5th Ave clear brush in front of stop sign- north end of road
18. Crescent- Lots of low over hanging branches east of 4th Ave
19. 161st st- trim around entering Lynden Township sign
20. Franklin Rd near 222nd St.- over hanging branches on road
21. Foxtail near Franklin intersection- branches over hanging Rd.
22. South/East end of Fulton Circle- Branches over hanging road
23. 216th St- trim tree hanging over dead end sign
24. 27th Ave- brush hanging over reflector sign
25. 4th AVE Trim brush in front of corner left sign near John Goenner's driveway
26. Trim brush in front of corner left sign just west of 168th St and 2nd Ave E

Garbage in the ROW:

1. Birchwood and CR 44- Bar table on side of road

Pot Holes:

1. Multiple pot hole issues along 200th St E between 21st Ave E and County Rd 145
2. Hubble RD- pot hole next to stop sign
3. Franklin Rd near Fulton Circle
4. 222nd St west of Opportunity DR

Roads Needing Repair

1. 8th ST edge of road washed out on hill
2. Lake Maria Rd Minimum maintenance section- needs grading and culvert exposed
3. Eagle Wood RD- hole in ditch next to culvert crossing RD just west of 5th AVE
4. 146th St- Washout on hill towards Alder
5. Hidden River- Manhole covers are sticking above Rd grade
6. 161st- shoulder of pavement tore up- entire road

Plugged Culverts

1. Lake Maria Rd both Plum creek culverts plugged- beaver
