List of issued raised during the tour are as followed:

Signage:

1. Stop ahead sign on 13th Ave needs replaced
2. 19643 Lake Maria Rd- 911 sign damaged and laying on ground
3. Plum Creek sign missing on Franklin
4. Franklin minimum maintenance section- welcome to Lynden Township sign missing- should have in stock?

Brush Clearing

1. Donaghue Circle- fallen tree in ROW needs to be removed, has been cut back but needs more attention
2. Donaghue Circle- brush blocking stop sign
3. Corner right sign blocked by brush on Eaglewood Rd, east bound near county rd 44
4. Intersection of 189th and 7th St- brush blocking corner left sign
5. Birchwood Rd- tree with trump sign needs to be cut back in ROW
6. 8th st- trim brush near north stop sign

Garbage in the ROW:

1. Van in ROW on Fairfax at 21833?- where driveway is needed
2. 208th St- tires and rims- **removed**
3. 9th St- pile of wood in driveway near ROW

Roads Needing Repair-

1. 8th Ave washouts on hill section of road
2. 200th very rough road
3. Lake Maria Rd- very rough for first ½ mile
4. 208th- very rough eastern section
5. Fox tail Ct- washout on shoulder of hill
6. Franklin- rough sections throughout
7. 13th St- very rough
8. 146th St- very rough on hill

Plugged Culverts

1. Lake Maria Rd- both culverts
